Subject: Report # FD-002-2026 - Fire Department UTV Request for Quotation Results

Recommendation

Be It Resolved that Council of the Township of Clearview hereby receive report # FD-002-2026 (Fire Department UTV Request for Quotation Results) dated April 27, 2026; and,

- 1) That Council approve the quotation submitted by J&R Cycle in the amount of \$42,233.47 (includes HST) for the purchase of one 2026 Polaris UTV.

Background

Clearview Fire and Emergency Services prides itself on delivering excellent and reliable service to residents and visitors to the Township of Clearview. As approved in the 2026 Budget, the Fire Departments current 2014 UTV is to be replaced to ensure we can continue to provide service for off road rescues and wildland fires with the enhanced capabilities of a larger unit.

Comments and Analysis

Per council direction from the March 23,2026 meeting, more options were to be explored for a UTV and a RFQ was posted with the criteria required to meet the needs of the Fire Department.

After reviewing quotations including specifications and vehicle warranty, it has been determined that a Polaris Ranger will be best suited for the Fire Department. It is being proposed to purchase a 2026 Polaris Ranger Crew XP1000 Northland Premium from J&R cycle for the price of \$42,233.47 with a 5-year warranty included in the price worth \$2000, standard warranty provided by the next closest Polaris bidder is 2 years.

Financial Implications

\$50,000 was allocated in the 2026 budget for the UTV replacement.
