Notice of approved Devil's Glen Provincial Park Management Plan amendment

Ontario Parks, part of the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, is releasing the approved amendment to the Devil's Glen Provincial Park Management Plan. This amendment is consistent with the park's natural environment classification and strengthens the protection of its natural and cultural heritage values.

The proposed management plan amendment was posted on the Environmental Registry of Ontario for a 49-day comment period, beginning August 1, 2025. Local Indigenous communities were directly notified of the opportunity to comment. All comments received were considered when making a decision on the proposal.

As a result of comments received, the final management plan includes an updated boundary to reflect the addition of 18 hectares of acquired land to the park, updated park classification of natural environment from recreation, updated zoning, and the addition of rock climbing as a permitted use and associated policies for the management of rock climbing.
